Motivation	• Students' Booster Bits, Imagine Museum levels, and avatars and their accessories: ◦ Booster Bits and Museum Levels are set to 0 the day of the reset ◦ Avatars and their accessories are deleted	• Student THINK Points (Imagine Math 3+ students): ◦ Deleted/set to 0 ◦ Returning students will begin accumulating THINK Points again in the new school year • Student avatars (Imagine Math 3+ students): ◦ Deleted ◦ Returning students will create new avatars in the new school year	• Students' Booster Bits, Imagine Museum levels, and avatars and their accessories: ◦ Booster Bits and Museum Levels are set to 0 the day of the reset ◦ Avatars and their accessories are deleted	• Stars, levels, earned backgrounds, and sidekicks: ◦ Stars and levels are set to 0 ◦ Backgrounds and sidekicks are removed
Playlists/ Pathways/ Assignments	• Playlists: Playlists and their associated activities are retained but students are no longer assigned to the playlists	• Imagine Math 3+ Pathways: ◦ All customer-created pathways are retained year-over-year ◦ Teacher and Administrator accounts remain along with the custom pathways they created ◦ After the new school year begins, the pathways will be there for teachers to assign to next year's students	• Playlists: ILL only	• Assignment Builder: Assignments are deleted for the new academic year
