


National Imagine Español® Growth Report 2024–2025


Imagine Español is a digital learning program designed to support Spanish language and literacy development for Spanish-speaking students in Grades K–5. It provides instruction in foundational skills such as phonological awareness, vocabulary, reading comprehension, and writing, all in Spanish. The program adapts to each student's needs and includes interactive activities, songs, and stories to promote engagement.

Data for approximately 55,000 Grade K–3 students who used Imagine Español during the 2024–2025 school year were analyzed to determine the association between program use and growth in benchmark performance. Grades 4–5 were not analyzed due to insufficient data. Figure 1 visualizes the association between program usage and benchmark score (percent correct) growth.



Maximizing Learning Outcomes

Figure 2 demonstrates the effect of using Imagine Español on benchmark performance disaggregated by grade and program usage. While growth was observed for all grades, students that met the recommended usage level of 20 or more hours in the school year achieved the most improvement.



Expected Growth

Table 1 summarizes the average benchmark score (percent correct) growth by grade that users of Imagine Español experienced during the 2024–2025 school year. While this summary data provides a valuable reference point, significant variability should be anticipated due to differences in student characteristics.
