If you are responsible for creating educators individually, select the Users & Classes/Groups button from the product portal (this action is done before selecting the Imagine+ Assessment tile). Once on the Users & Classes/Groups page, click Add button to create an educator. Manage educators to update existing accounts and/or update settings as needed. Select Users & Classes/Groups button from product portal > Educators tab and action.
 Student Management Ensure students have Imagine+ Assessment accounts: If your district/school automatically pulls students from your Student Information System (SIS), check that your students are showing up properly. If you are responsible for creating students individually, select the Users & Classes/Groups button from the product portal (this action is done before selecting the Imagine+ Assessment tile). Once on the Users & Classes/Groups page, click Add. Manage students to update existing student accounts and/or update student settings as needed. Select Users & Classes/Groups button from product portal > Students tab and action.
 Classroom Management Ensure classes have been created: If your district/school automatically pulls classes from your Student Information System (SIS), check that your classes are correct. If you are responsible for creating classes/groups, select the Users & Classes/Groups button from the product portal (this action is done before selecting the Imagine+ Assessment tile). Once on the Users & Classes/Groups page, click Add button to create a class/group. Manage classes/groups to update existing classes and/or update settings as needed. Select Users & Classes/Groups button from product portal > Classes/Groups tab.
